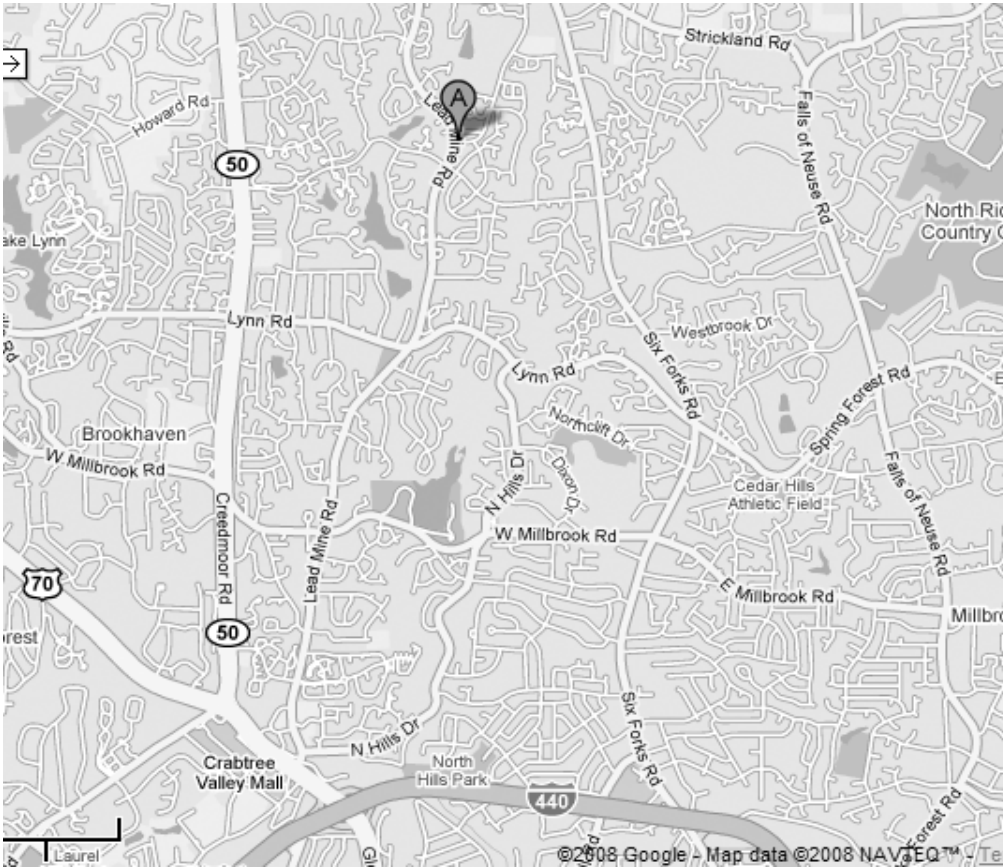
## Paw Prints Animal Rescue Spay/Neuter Policy

Paw Prints Animal Rescue charges a \$100.00 spay/neuter fee with every unaltered animal that is adopted. This is to insure the animal will be altered before the animal reaches 6 month of age. After the animal is adopted, all shots, spaying or neutering are your responsibility. When you sign the contract, that is what you are promising to do. To assist you in obtaining a cost effective spay/neuter for your pet, Paw Prints offers two options:

- Utilize Paw Prints partner vet, Dr. Farmer at Greystone Animal Hospital, and the \$100 fee will cover the spay/neuter.
  - Contact her at 919-676-1711 to schedule the spay/neuter. Be sure to tell her that you have adopted your pet from Paw Prints and take the medical jacket with you to the appointment.
  - Her office hours are 9:00 am - 4:00 pm.
  - The puppy should weigh less than 30 lbs and can be spayed/neutered at 14 weeks of age (minimum) up to 6 months of age (maximum). If appropriate age, the puppy will also be vaccinated for rabies at this time (no additional charge).
  - The puppy can also be microchipped at this time for an additional \$15.00.
- You may choose to have the animal spayed or neutered at the vet of your choice. Once the animal has been spayed or neutered, you can provide Paw Prints Animal Rescue with a copy of your receipt and we will reimburse you the \$100 spay/neuter fee.

Paw Prints Animal Rescue is committed to doing all we can to stem the tide of homeless animals by requiring that all animals adopted from our program be neutered or spayed. This spay/neuter policy is standard practice with rescue groups who adopt out animals before they are spayed. This practice allows adopters to adopt animals who are younger but also insures that the animal is altered. It also allows the owner to choose who spays or neuters their animal.
